

## Reasons for Approval/Denial/Revocation of Transfers

The following are acceptable reasons for granting approval of a transfer in accordance with Board Policy FDA (LOCAL):

- Change of Residence (Current resident leaves TMISD attendance zone):
  - Remain at current school until end of current year
  - Student may apply for continuing enrollment as specified below
  - Pending acquisition of another home (move to be completed within specified time frame) and necessary documentation provided
- Meets criteria for entry:
  - Satisfactory discipline record from home campus
  - Documentation of compliance with Compulsory Attendance Law
  - Final grades for semester year at 80 average for each core subject – Final Grade
  - The following achievement scores will also be considered in determining entry eligibility:
    - Texas Assessment of Knowledge and Skills (TAKS) scores at “Meet Minimal Expectations” or above,
    - Satisfactory scores on Standardized Achievement Tests at 50<sup>th</sup> percentile or above
    - Successful achievement on District-delivered academic screening for home-schooled or non schooled students
- Annual renewal will be based on students meeting eligibility criteria each spring.

### Reasons for Denial

The following are reasons for denial of a transfer in accordance with Board Policy FDA (LOCAL):

- Record of poor attendance, late arrivals, late pick ups, and/or disciplinary infractions at home campus
- For the purpose of participating in an extra-curricular activity at receiving campus
- Falsification of information
- Failure to meet district criteria for a transfer

### Reasons for Revocation

Transfers may be revoked any time during the school year. The following are reasons for revocation of a transfer in accordance with Board Policy FDA (LOCAL):

- Repeated failure to abide by the rules specified in the *Discipline Management Plan and Student Code* or the student commits a disciplinary infraction that mandates removal to an AEP or JJAEP
- Documented pattern of late arrivals, late pickups, and/or poor attendance
- Falsification of information
- Failure to maintain a 70 average per core subject area
- Failure to “Meet Minimal Expectations” or above on TAKS scores
